- 2. A completed Scholarship Application Form.
- 3. The Nominator or Nominee <u>must</u> provide an original diploma <u>and</u> a copy of same as well as transcripts (originals if possible) and proof of outstanding achievement if appropriate. Original documents will be returned.
- 4. A letter of recommendation from a teacher, professor or instructor as required in the Scholarship Application Form.

Outstanding Achievement nominations require:

- 1. This form.
- 2. Proof of outstanding achievement. Such proof would normally be in the form of diplomas, transcripts, awards and trophies but other proofs **may** be considered.
- 3. Original documents and other proofs will be returned.
- 4. While usually in the areas of academics and sports, the Alberta Thai Association may also recognize other appropriate special achievements of members. Suitable proof(s) of such achievements is required.

Recognition and Other Awards nominations require:

- 1. This form.
- 2. A written outline of the services that the nominee(s) have provided to Alberta Thai Association. Note that the nominees in this category need not be members of the Association.
